DECLARACIÓN DE APOYO A "NUESTRA AGENDA COMÚN"

The Millennium Project, la Federación Mundial de Estudios del Futuro y la Asociación de Profesionales Futuristas, como adición a nuestra carta abierta al Secretario General de la ONU, Antonio Guterres, entregada electrónicamente el 2 de septiembre de 2021 y respaldada por 205 líderes de todo el mundo:

1. Celebramos el informe del Secretario General de la ONU, Antonio Guterres, sobre "Nuestra Agenda Común", entregado este mes a la 76º Asamblea General. Esta gran estrategia de la ONU considera muchos y excelentes desarrollos, incluido un Laboratorio de Futuros, una Cumbre sobre el Futuro y una mejor preparación para prevenir y responder a los principales riesgos globales.
2. Este nuevo énfasis en la prospectiva estratégica global para la humanidad es único en la historia de las Naciones Unidas y del mundo.
3. Coincidimos plenamente con la propuesta del Secretario General de que será importante que las Naciones Unidas publiquen periódicamente un Informe de prospectiva estratégica y riesgos mundiales, y proponga una Plataforma de Emergencia, que se convocará en respuesta a las complejas crisis globales.
4. Consideramos que la propuesta de 202 líderes de todo el mundo que presentamos hace unos días al Secretario General, solicitando una nueva Oficina de la ONU para coordinar la investigación global para prevenir la extinción humana, corresponde precisamente al espíritu y contexto del Informe "Nuestra Agenda Común".
5. Aunque la Oficina de la ONU propuesta es para identificar las amenazas de extinción de la humanidad y cómo prevenirlas, The Millennium Project: hace un seguimiento sobre dónde estamos ganando (educación, longevidad, reducción de la pobreza, etc.) y donde estamos perdiendo (medio ambiente, crimen organizado, concentración de riqueza, malestar social y terrorismo, etc.). Nuestro análisis de tendencias muestra que la humanidad está ganando más que perdiendo, pero dónde está perdiendo es muy grave, y un área que necesita una mejor investigación son las amenazas a la supervivencia humana a largo plazo.
6. Nos declaramos dispuestos a colaborar en su implementación, poniendo a disposición nuestra colección completa de estudios e investigaciones realizados durante los últimos 26 años, y la capacidad de The Millennium Project, que reúne a un grupo de expertos transdisciplinario de prospectiva, que ha desarrollado una red global de 68 nodos (grupos de personas e instituciones orientadas al futuro) alrededor del mundo, que han involucrado a más de 4.500 expertos en sus acciones de investigación y seguimiento, que colaboran diariamente en estudios de futuros para la anticipación y prevención de amenazas estratégicas a la humanidad. Moviliza sus

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recursos descentralizados para promover conceptos y métodos de prospectiva en todo el mundo.

7. En concreto, The Millennium Project puede contribuir a esta iniciativa y a la prospectiva estratégica (punto 6) en el Compromiso 8 de la Nuestra Agenda Común.

8. Proponemos que la Secretaría de la ONU lleve a cabo un estudio de viabilidad de la idea de una pequeña oficina para recopilar, coordinar y respaldar la investigación sobre las amenazas a la extinción humana y las estrategias de prevención, y dirigir propuestas sobre cómo éstos temas pueden calzar con los posibles cambios en el sistema de las Naciones Unidas.

9. Tenemos la intención de enviar un informe, a su oficina en los próximos días, sobre amenazas como:

- Debilitamiento del escudo magnético de la Tierra que nos protege de la radiación solar mortal.
- Descargas masivas de sulfuro de hidrógeno (H₂S) de océanos desoxigenados, causadas por el avanzado calentamiento global.
- Nanotecnología maliciosa (incluido el problema de la "sustancia pegajosa gris")
- Pérdida de control sobre formas futuras de inteligencia artificial.
- Un solo individuo, que algún día actuando en solitario podría crear y desplegar un arma de destrucción masiva (probablemente de biología sintética).
- Escalada de la guerra nuclear.
- Pandemias incontrolables y más graves.
- Un accidente con el acelerador de partículas.
- Estallidos de rayos gamma solares.
- Una colisión de asteroides

La cooperación internacional en este tipo de investigación es fundamental, especialmente sobre cómo abordar estas amenazas. Planeamos discutir la propuesta de la Oficina de Amenazas Estratégicas de la ONU en todo el mundo a través de nuestro próximo informe, el State of the Future (20a edición) que se traduce a varios idiomas y se utiliza como base para muchas conferencias, talleres, cursos universitarios, programas de capacitación, y pondremos sus resultados a disposición de la Secretaría General, para contribuir a los objetivos de "Nuestra Agenda Común".
